Finding answers on 24 Hour Crisis/Info Line

Sometimes, prayers are answered.

For 37 year old, university educated Sheila (a pseudonym) her prayers for an escape from her controlling, drug addicted husband, together with a co-worker's advice and her own courage, helped her dial 941-HELP, the 24 Hour Crisis/Info Line at FTP.



"I now see the choices I have."

Sheila felt trapped, fearful of making her own decisions, wondering how she could find affordable housing or financially survive on her own.

During her three week stay at the shelter, she talked to counsellors, used legal support services, and found help in making the transition for both herself and her children. Her kids took part in the children's program and discovered the encouragement that comes from knowing they're not alone.

"I accomplished a lot in a short time. I feel settled and at peace. I now see the choices I have," she said.

"FTP is a good place to stay, to gather momentum, strengthen yourself. It's a community here. The Dali Lama said 'What we lack in this world is compassion for others.' Here at FTP, I found compassion."
